DATES: We offer the following sessions:

Session One: SUNDAY, JUNE 13 - SATURDAY, JUNE 26 (14 days)
Session Two: SUNDAY, JUNE 27 - SATURDAY, JULY 10 (14 days)
Session Three: SUNDAY, JULY 11 - WEDNESDAY, JULY 28 (18 days)
Trailseekers A: SUNDAY, JULY 11 - MONDAY, JULY 19 (9 days)*
Trailseekers B: TUESDAY, JULY 20 - WEDNESDAY, JULY 28 (9 days)*

Campers may also enroll for any combination of sessions.

*Trailseeker sessions are for first-time campers, ages 6-10



TUITION:

For almost EVERYTHING including: full lodging and care; all activities; transportation from/to Phoenix (optional); basic laundry service; cabin group photo; nourishing snacks twice daily; minor medical/accident insurance; and stamped postcards home weekly.

DISCOUNT: Families deduct 7% for 2nd and each additional sibling.

VISITING: June 26, July 10, and July 28. Specifics regarding these "Open House/Brunch" mornings will be sent to enrolled families. Please ensure that family and friends are aware that visits **MUST** conform to this schedule **ONLY**, without exception.

PAYMENT: Deposit (above) due upon application. All fees must be fully paid by April 10. After April 10, fees are due upon enrolling. \$30.00 charge for any returned check.

EXTRA COSTS: Crafts, sewing, or photography supplies; personal items (toiletries, writing materials, extra stamps, etc.); laundry service exceeding \$10.00 per session (\$15.00 for Session 3). We do not sell any edibles, gum or pop, as we provide three good meals daily, plus the between-meal snacks. Deposit for incidentals = \$35.00 per session. At summer's end we refund remaining balance or send a statement for any overdraft.

Usual play clothes (in good taste) - jeans, T-shirts, shorts (finger-tip length), modest one-piece swimsuits or tasteful tankinis - are what we wear in camp. **Do not bring the following:**

- sleeveless shirts • low neckline tops • sheer, spaghetti-strap, or bare-shoulder shirts • no visible tummies or underwear
- no drooping shorts/pants • nothing fancy - (Must withstand commercial washers/dryers) • two-piece swimsuits (tasteful one-piece, only) • heavy make-up • dangling earrings (for safety) • shorts or hemlines that are too short (at least finger-tip length) • hairstyle in the eyes, extreme, or (for males) cut lower than collar • articles that advertise tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or send potentially offensive or inappropriate messages.

Also, please don't bring edibles • comics • gum • electric equipment or anything with an "on/off" switch • costly toys, or good jewelry/watches.

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
